This will apply to 2nd-12th grades. If a student is quarantined by the Health Department, a medical provider, or self-quarantining, they will have the option to receive their instruction in real-time, by logging on to their Chromebook or computer and participating in their class(es) via webcam and/or audio. Students are required to login in and participate in order to be marked present for the hour/class.

If a Kindergarten or 1st grade student is quarantined, they will be getting their work sent home.

The school will be open and operating as usual each day, for those that are not currently in quarantine or ill. Our goal is to try to keep our students and staff safe and healthy during these difficult times, while offering a quality education to all.
